
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SEPTEMBER 4, 2022 PRIMARY LIFE APPLICATION STORY

"That's a fine thing to do," said Dad. "You're very determined and you have faith you can do it, don't vou?"




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Circle Puzzle

Circle every third word in the circle puzzle, starting from the beginning, to find a very important sentence from Hebrews. Then color the pictures in the puzzle.




Your child learned about living a life pleasing to God today. They identified one way they can grow closer to God this week. You can talk about it with them and do that activity together!

We can have faith in God, even though we can't see Him because He is good, He is powerful, and He is with us always.

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
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Crossword Puzzle
